With a beautiful smile herself, Dr Benson first acknowledged that she wanted to practice dentistry when she was in orthodontic treatment for three years as a young teen. She said there are many reasons to have orthodontic treatment, more than just cosmetic. Misaligned or crooked teeth are difficult to clean. A bite that is off can cause abnormal wear of tooth surfaces, difficulty in chewing, speaking, increase the stress on the gum

tissue and supporting bone. "It is also important to have an orthodontic consultation by age seven according to the American Association of Orthodontist," she said. "Early orthodontic treatment can take advantage of growth spurts during treatment for fast results. The longer one waits, the longer the treatment in certain cases." She has treated patients that still had some of their baby teeth and patients in the 60s and 70s, but the most common age for treatment is during the teen years.

Dr. Benson is a native of Battle Creek, Michigan and has lived in Chesterfield for five years. She graduated from Michigan State University with honors and attended dental school at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. While in dental school Dr. Benson became involved in several outreach programs such as, the Traverse City Migrant Worker Program, Colgate Bright Smiles Bright Future and the Marshall Becker Dental Clinic.

Immediately following dental school she became a general practice resident in dentistry at the John D. Dingell Veterans Administrations Medical Center. After residency, she worked as a general dentist for five years in the metropolitan area of Detroit. Dr. Benson completed her specialty resi-

dency in orthodontics at Howard University College of Dentistry in Washington D.C.

During her orthodontic training she served as Chief-Resident. In 2004 she became the youngest President of the Detroit District Dental Society (Central Branch).


According to the American Association of Orthodontist, "All orthodontist are dentist first. Out of 100 dental school graduates, only six go on to become orthodontists."
